

Mission Statement

To promote the rights of people who experience mental illness, to have valued social roles and access to work and community participation.

What is Canefields Clubhouse?

Canefields Clubhouse is a community, intentionally organised to support individuals living with the effects of mental illness. Through participation in a Clubhouse people are given the opportunities to rejoin the world of friendship, family, important work, employment, education, and to access the services and supports they may individually need. A Clubhouse is restorative environment for people who have had their lives drastically disrupted and need the support of others who believe that recovery from mental illness is possible for all.

Canefields Clubhouse opened its doors in 2000 and is one of 340 Clubhouses internationally.



Work-Ordered Day

Members and staff work side-by-side and share responsibility in the operation of the Clubhouse. The work-ordered day operates from 8:30am to 4:30pm Monday to Friday, with the choice to participate in the following units:

1. Employment and Education
2. Administration
3. Catering



Employment Program

The Employment Program is organised by the Employment and Education Unit (E&E) and assists members to reach their vocational goals, focusing on relationships so that the support provided is tailored to each member's individual requirements. Transitional Employment (TE), a component of the program enables members to work for award wages in a range of highly supporting, part-time positions in the community for a period of six to nine months, while building stamina and confidence.

Housing Program

Housing is a basic necessity of life. Canefields Clubhouse offer support to its members in order to access and maintain safe and affordable housing in accordance with their needs. The No Interest Loan Scheme (NILS) is available to provide members the opportunity to access essential household items INTEREST FREE!

Social Recreation

In addition to work opportunities , Clubhouse provides evening, weekend, and holiday social and recreational activities. Outings include theme parks, visits to the markets, social lunches and dinners, sports days, movies, beach days and more! Canefields also celebrates holidays on their actual day such as Christmas Day.
